He completed his PhD in Medical Pharmacology at Gazi University Faculty of Medicine in 2014. He became an Associate Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology in 2013 and has over 100 articles and over 500 citations in national and international journals (h-index: 15 [01.09.2018]). He is still working as a chief of Gynecology Department in Etlik Zübeyde Hanım Women's Health Training and Research Hospital and continuing his scientific studies.
